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CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

Membership

- Membership is inclusive of all family members residing in the same household and is only open to people 11 years or older.
- The principal member must be aged 16 years or older. Only those members aged 16 years and above have voting roles at the Annual General Meeting.
- Only children aged 11 years and older are allowed to handle dogs in classes. Younger children however, are allowed to attend class (at the discretion of the instructor) with a supervising adult, to watch and learn and are expected to be quiet and attentive throughout class.
- Only financial members may bring their dogs on Club grounds. Non-members are not permitted to be on the Club's grounds at any time.

Fees

- Joining, annual and grounds only fees cover all family members and dogs living in the same household.
- All fees include GST.
- Activity fees are payable **per dog** enrolled in each activity.
- Fees are for a 12 month period which covers 5 terms of 8 weeks (40 classes) and are calculated starting from the session that you first enrolled in (i.e. February through to February; April through to April etc).
- Memberships that have lapsed more than 6 months will need to pay the joining fee again (\$50.00).

 - Please forward (email, post or in person) your completed application form, a copy of your dog's vaccination certificate/s and a copy of your transaction receipt, to the office as soon as possible after making your payment.
- Cheque
 - Please make cheques payable to the ACT Companion Dog Club.
 - You may pay by cheque either by post or in person at the office.
- Cash
 - Cash payments can only be made at the office during office hours or during regular Obedience training times. Please do not send cash in the post.
- Eftpos and Credit Card payments are not available.

Dogs

- All dogs are welcome but must be fully vaccinated against distemper, canine hepatitis and parvovirus before attending the clubs grounds. Current AVA protocols of triennial vaccinations and an annual booster for canine cough are accepted. Homeopathic vaccinations are not accepted.
- Bitches in season may not be brought onto the club grounds. Owners can attend classes to keep up with their dogs training at home.
- All dogs must be on lead at all times, except in designated off-lead areas and during training sessions (and only when given specific permission by instructor to be off-lead).
- All dogs must be on-lead in the Club car park at all times.
- Handlers **must** remove their dog's excreta from the Club grounds and environs and place it in the bins provided.
- Any dog suffering from any illness, skin problems or other contagion is not permitted on Club grounds until a vet has pronounced the condition non-contagious and the dog is fit to attend class.

Office Hours

- Monday to Friday, 10am to 1pm. Please leave a message on the answering machine if calling outside those times and your call will be returned as soon as possible.
- The office is also open during regular Obedience training times which are:
 - Wednesdays 9.30am – 12pm
 - Thursdays 7pm – 9pm
