



Roles of the Flyball Sub-Committee

There are 8 positions available, these are Convenor, Competition Organiser, Training Manager, Assistant Training Manager, AFA Representative, Treasurer, Equipment Manager and Publicity Officer.

Details of these positions are as follows:

- The **Convenor** for flyball and oversees the day-to-day running of the sub-committee and attends Main CDC Committee meeting to represent Flyball.
- The **AFA Representative** handles everything concerning the AFA. This person is usually also on the AFA Committee.
- The **Training Manager** coordinates the classes, instructors, promotion of dogs and challenge days.
- The **Assistant Training Manager** helps the Training Manager with the above duties. Training is a huge area of flyball and there is a lot to do.
- The **Treasurer** handles all things money related. All competition entries, uniform and fundraising money goes to the Treasurer. It would be a benefit if this person has accounting experience.
- The **Competition Manager** coordinates all of our competitions and demonstrations. This includes team entries, organising prizes, volunteer's, equipment set-up and the rest.
- The **Equipment Manager** makes sure all of our equipment is in tiptop shape. They are also responsible for the tidiness of the shed and the purchasing of new equipment.
- The **Publicity Officer** coordinates the newsletter and submissions into the club magazine. Also talking to the media and organising sponsorship.
