









SHED RULES

The Queanbeyan Showground Pavilion (the “Shed”) is an inside space which is great for training but does necessitate a few Shed Rules, as it means a number of dogs are sharing an enclosed space.

-  Try and arrive about 10 minutes before class. This gives you time to set up your chair, crate or mat and take your dog outside for a “sniff” and toileting.
-  While in the Shed all dogs must be under their handler’s control. This means on a lead or in a crate unless they are working.
-  Be aware that some dogs do not like to be in close proximity with dogs they don’t know. Try to ensure that you and your dog have space and be respectful of other dogs’ space.
-  During class time try and keep your dog’s focus on you and don’t let them socialise with other dogs. It’s good focus training and also teaches them this is a “work” space not a “play” place. Dogs can socialise and play in the grassed areas outside the Shed.
-  If your dog is showing signs of needing a break from class (for “potty” or other reasons) feel free to take them outside for a few minutes, but please try not to disrupt the rest of the class.
-  If your dog has an “accident” in the Shed, please clean it up! There is a mop for puddles, please don’t be afraid to ask where it is.
