






THE YELLOW RIBBON



Many dog communities are adopting the Yellow Ribbon policy. A yellow ribbon on a dog's collar or lead means they need some space.

There are many reasons why a dog may need space, for example:

-  It may have health issues or be in training for a specific purpose.
-  It may be a rescue dog being rehabilitated (the world can be a very scary place for these dogs).
-  It may just have had a bad experience with another dog or just not like the kind of friendly dogs who always want to say "Hi!"

We supply yellow ribbons that you can tie on your dog's collar or lead if they are not comfortable being in close proximity with other dogs (or people).



We also supply green ribbons, as our hope is that in time some of these dogs will feel comfortable enough in the group and environment to be approached in a respectful and non-threatening way with the permission of the handler.



If you see a yellow ribbon on a dog's collar or lead please be considerate and give them space (ask the handler if you're not sure how much).
